OUR KEY POLICIES FOR THE 2019 FEDERAL ELECTION

✓ AUSTRALIA COMES FIRST

Australian interests must come first. Families, employers, workers, pensioners, soldiers, veterans, the frail, sick and homeless must take priority over globalism, foreign regimes and criminals. Career politicians selling off public assets in the midst of a resources boom, yet generating billions in public debt, are committing economic suicide.

✓ FREEDOM OF SPEECH

Scrap federal and state laws inhibiting free speech. Article 19 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights guarantees freedom of speech. Government agencies must protect this fundamental freedom.

✓ HOLD MPs TO ACCOUNT

Parliamentarians represent the people and must be held to account. A simple mechanism to apply a no confidence vote for an MP not doing their job is mandatory.

✓ CUT IMMIGRATION

Zero net immigration with preference for migrants and refugees who speak English, share our values and contribute to our Commonwealth. We support mandatory visa cancellation and deportation for serious criminals. No more onshore appeals. This will help us to stop the Islamisation of Australia.

✓ RE-INDUSTRIALISE AUSTRALIA

Supporting Australian industry, farmers and businesses by levying imported goods and services we already produce here will protect Australian suppliers and fund the initiative. It's vital we control our basic means of production, air and sea ports, utilities, communication networks and national railroads. Special protection for our merchant fleet, fishing industry and Qantas, our international flag carrier.

✓ FIX THE ENERGY CRISIS

Ensure access to affordable, reliable energy. Support hydroelectric, advanced nuclear and clean coal as our primary energy sources. A domestic quota for oil and gas exploration will stop the buying back of fuel from the countries we export to overseas. End subsidies for unreliable wind and solar schemes. Guarantee pensioners an 'at cost' price for utilities.

✓ FAIRER SIMPLER TAXES

No more complicated schemes to tax the income of workers and producers. Tax consumption at the point of sale. Reduce income tax for individuals and companies, while adjusting the GST. This attracts investment, provides jobs, lowers the risk of tax evasion and minimises off-shoring of profits.

✓ LIVEABLE AGE PENSION

Pensioners need a fixed age pension at 75% of minimum wage. Adjusted with inflation while allowing hard-earned savings to supplement their income. Increase superannuation contributions.

✓ SCRAP \$0.40 FUEL LEVY

The extra levy of over 40 cents per litre is an unfair penalty. Transport is essential for all Australians.

✓ HEAL OUR HEALTH SYSTEM

Encourage those who can afford it to join private health funds. Create more private/public day care centres to take the pressure off the overloaded public system. Cut down red tape for the health industry

✓ VOTE AS YOU SEE FIT

Replace mandatory preferential voting with flexible preferential voting. We should not be forced to give our vote to parties or candidates we reject.

✓ BANKING ON AUSTRALIA

We support a publicly-owned and not-for-profit Australian Savings & Loans Bank. Providing basic banking services and default superannuation for all workers, investing only in Australian mortgages, bonds and stocks.
